1 COMPLAINT

Plaintiff Prophet Walker ("Plaintiff") alleges as follows against Defendants Mike Gipson ("Gipson") and Angel Gonzalez ("Gonzalez") (collectively, "Defendants"):

#### I. INTRODUCTION

This case is about a politician's intentional and malicious disregard for California's election laws and libel laws. Assemblyman Mike Gipson brazenly violated California election laws in order to win election to his current office. During his November 2014 election campaign for the 64th California State Assembly District, Gipson paid thousands of dollars to Angel Gonzalez, a consultant with a criminal record of producing false and illegal mailers, to falsely attack his election opponent, Prophet Walker. Gipson then compounded his illegal campaign tactics by lying to voters, supporters, staff, and direct mail consultant about how an unlawful mailer attacking Walker was created. Initially blaming a campaign volunteer, the truth was later revealed that Gipson hired Gonzalez for the specific purpose of creating a mailer that violated California election code. Gipson's intention to violate the law was made even more apparent by his own decision to hide his actions from his campaign consultant.

As the election approached, without regard for law or fair play, Gipson ignored statutory election campaign practices to portray his opponent, Prophet Walker, in the most heinous light possible by creating a mailer with Gonzalez depicting a photo-shopped image of Walker in a hooded sweatshirt wielding a gun juxtaposed against a photo of Gipson in a lawman's uniform. Gipson failed to include the obligatory statutory language for this campaign advertisement, clarifying that the depiction was not an accurate factual representation. Gipson's campaign tactics go far beyond lawful election campaign practices. A candidate creating a false image of his opponent in a hooded sweatshirt wielding a handgun without the required statutory disclaimer is clearly outside the law and precisely the type of campaign tactic the statutes are meant to prevent.

Gipson's lies to his own campaign consultant and the resulting multiple lies to the public helped Gipson win the election to become a member of the California State Assembly for the 64<sup>th</sup> District. Gipson's lies unequivocally show he acted with malice, in violation of the California Election Code while causing great damage to Prophet Walker's public standing and prospects for employment. Gipson must be held accountable for his deplorable actions.

Plaintiff Prophet Walker brings this complaint against Defendants Mike Gipson and Angel Gonzalez based on a false and misleading campaign advertisement. By this action for violation of Elections Code Section 20010 and defamation, Plaintiff seeks recovery for the damages caused by the defendants' actions.

#### II. PARTIES

- 1. Plaintiff Prophet Walker is an individual residing in Carson, California, in the County of Los Angeles.
- 2. Defendant Mike Gipson is an individual who, upon information and belief, resides in Carson, California, in the County of Los Angeles at the time of the events alleged in this lawsuit.
- 3. Defendant Angel Gonzalez is an individual who, upon information and belief, resides in the County of Los Angeles at the time of the events alleged in this lawsuit.
- 4. Upon information and belief, Defendants Gipson and Gonzalez acted in concert with other individuals and/or entities to perform the acts alleged in this complaint, but Plaintiff is presently unaware of the true names, natures, and identities of such persons or entities, or of their specific role in the events alleged in this complaint. Plaintiff therefore alleges these unknown defendant entities as DOE Defendants 1-10. Plaintiff is diligently searching for further information about the identity and nature of additional defendant parties and will amend this

#### III. GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

5. Plaintiff and Defendant Gipson were opposing candidates in the November 2014 election for the 64th California State Assembly District. In the course of the campaign, numerous political advertisements supporting and criticizing the parties were distributed to voters in the 64th Assembly District.

6. On or about October 31, 2014, Plaintiff discovered a print advertisement critical of him and supporting Defendant Gipson that featured a photo of Plaintiff superimposed on the body of an individual in a hooded sweatshirt and menacingly pointing a handgun (the "Mailer"). A true and correct copy of the Mailer is attached hereto as Exhibit A. The Mailer includes the statement "PAID FOR BY MIKE GIPSON FOR ASSEMBLY 2014." Unlike most fabricated images used by campaigns and created through digital editing (which are exaggerated or otherwise involve parody), this image was clearly intended to appear as a real and true photo. Its sole purpose was to persuade voters that Prophet Walker had been photographed in a hoodie brandishing a handgun in order to sway the election in Gipson's favor.

Because the photo of Plaintiff in the Mailer was fabricated and lacked disclaimers required under the California Elections Code, Plaintiff directed his legal counsel to send a letter to Gipson on or about October 31, 2014 demanding that, among other things, Gipson's campaign cease distribution of the Mailer and

issue a statement to any voters who received the piece stating that the photo of Plaintiff was fabricated and not an accurate representation of fact.

Defendant Gipson's counsel responded on or about November 1, 2014 8. claiming the distribution of the Mailer had ceased with an acknowledgment posted to Defendant Gipson's campaign website. A true and correct copy of the

acknowledgment is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

- 9. On information and belief, days before the election, Gipson hired Angel Gonzalez, a consultant known to have a criminal record of producing false and illegal mailers, specifically to create the Mailer and sway the election in his favor. Gipson paid Gonzalez \$7,714.00 for "campaign literature and mailings" according to Gipson's campaign financial disclosure report.
- 10. On information and belief, Gipson oversaw, approved and participated with Gonzalez in the creation and dissemination of the Mailer. Gipson retained Gonzalez for the specific purpose of creating false ads about Plaintiff as part of his campaign strategy. Gipson knew of and retained Gonzalez for his reputation and experience in creating false and illegal mailers for other campaigns. Gipson knew the Mailer was not true or factual when he authorized its dissemination.
- 11. On information and belief, Gonzalez was convicted of misdemeanors for sending out misleading mailers twice. On information and belief, in 2002, Angel Gonzalez was convicted of a felony conspiracy charge reduced to a misdemeanor at his sentencing for sending out attack mailers with copies of fake official documents.
- 12. On information and belief, in a separate case, he was convicted of two misdemeanor counts of sending out misleading campaign fliers.

#### FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

### (Violation of Elections Code Section 20010 - Against All Defendants)

- 13. Plaintiff hereby incorporates the allegations contained in paragraphs 1 through 12 above as though fully set forth herein.
- 14. The Mailer contains pictures or photographs of a person or persons into which the image of Plaintiff was superimposed.
- 15. Use of Plaintiff's photograph in this manner created a false representation that Plaintiff actually was in a hooded sweatshirt and was

menacingly pointing a handgun. By this, the public were led to believe this image was a real photograph of Plaintiff and actually depicted him holding a handgun during the commission of a crime.

- 16. On information and belief, Defendants knew that Plaintiff's image had been superimposed in the photograph in the Mailer to create such false representations, or, alternatively, Defendants had a reckless disregard of whether or not the image of Plaintiff had been superimposed on the photographs to create a false representation.
- 17. The photograph of Plaintiff in the Mailer does not include, pursuant to Elections Code Section 20010(b), the statement "This picture is not an accurate representation of fact."
  - 18. Wherefore, Plaintiff prays for relief as set forth below.

#### **SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION**

#### (Libel per Se, Against All Defendants)

- 19. Plaintiff hereby incorporates the allegations contained in paragraphs 1 through 18 above as though fully set forth herein.
- 20. The photograph of Plaintiff in the Mailer superimposed on the body of an individual in a hooded sweatshirt and menacingly pointing a handgun, as alleged above, is libelous of Plaintiff on its face as it exposes him to hatred, contempt, ridicule, or obloquy, or causes him to be shunned or avoided, or which has a tendency to injure him in his occupation.
- 21. Defendants caused the Mailer to be distributed to thousands of potential voters in the 64th Assembly District.
- 22. The potential voters reasonably understood that the manufactured photograph was of Plaintiff, as his face was superimposed and his name appeared below the photograph.
  - 23. The photograph of Plaintiff in the Mailer was false as it was created

by Defendants by superimposing a photograph of Plaintiff's face onto another person's body.

- 24. Defendants knew the photograph of Plaintiff in the Mailer was false or acted with reckless disregard for the truth or falsity of the depiction in the photograph. Defendants knew, and relied upon, viewers of the Mailer seeing it and believing that Plaintiff was a gun toting criminal. The very purpose for the Mailer was for viewers to rely upon the falsity of the Mailer to sway their vote in the election. Defendants intended for viewers of the Mailer to believe that Plaintiff was a gun toting criminal running for election and to withhold votes from Plaintiff in the election or vote for Defendant Gipson instead of Plaintiff.
- In committing the acts alleged herein, Defendants have acted with the 25. express intent of defaming and besmirching Plaintiff's reputation. Defendants have acted toward Plaintiff with malice, fraud, and oppression, entitling Plaintiff to punitive damages pursuant to California Civil Code section 3294 in an amount to be proved at trial.
- As a result of the dissemination of the Mailer, which was false, 26. Plaintiff was damaged in his business, occupation and/or reputation. Plaintiff lost employment opportunities as a result of the Mailer.
  - Wherefore, Plaintiff prays for relief as set forth below. 27.


#### PRAYER FOR RELIEF
